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3	CHAIRPERSON WONG-HERNANDEZ: Good afternoon.
4	Having gone to 2:00 o'clock, we're going to call the meeting
5	of the State Allocation Board to order. Secretary, will you
6	please call the roll.
7	MS. JONES: Senator Allen.
8	Senator Nguyen.
9	SENATOR NGUYEN: Here.
10	MS. JONES: Senator Pan.
11	SENATOR PAN: Here.
12	MS. JONES: Assemblymember Nazarian.
13	Assemblymember Chavez.
14	ASSEMBLYMEMBER CHAVEZ: Here.
15	MS. JONES: Assemblymember O'Donnell.
16	ASSEMBLYMEMBER O'DONNELL: Here.

1 CHAIRPERSON WONG-HERNANDEZ: And Mr. Nazarian. 2 Thank you. Welcome. 3 So a guorum has been established, and the first 4 order of business today the Board is going to adjourn into a 5 closed session. Pursuant to Government Code 6 7 Section 11126(e)(2)(b), the Board will meet in closed session for the purposes of conferring with and receiving 8 9 advice from its legal counsel that based on existing facts 10 and circumstances, there is a significant exposure to 11 litigation against the state body. 12 The SAB is going into closed session to discuss 13 the matter of the CCI adjustments to grant levels -- grant 14 funding levels with its counsel. 15 Before we move into closed session, is there any 16 public comment? Seeing none, I would ask that all members 17 of the public please depart from the room and we will 18 reconvene the meeting at the completion of our discussion. 19 Thank you for understanding that we want to start 20 here and then we'll get to the other items on the agenda. 21 (Whereupon at 2:04 p.m., the open meeting was recessed 22 for the closed session and resumed as follows at 3:22 p.m.) 23 CHAIRPERSON WONG-HERNANDEZ: State Allocation 24 Board is reconvened in open session. We finished discussing 25 the CCI adjustments to grant levels -- grant funding levels

1 with Board counsel. 2 Tomorrow, a nonconfidential version of the 3 materials discussed in closed session will be made available on the Office of Public School Construction website beneath 4 5 the link to the agenda for today's meeting. 6 And now we're ready to move on to action items 7 starting with the Minutes. 8 MS. SILVERMAN: Minutes are ready for your 9 approval. 10 CHAIRPERSON WONG-HERNANDEZ: Hopefully, everyone's 11 reviewed. 12 SENATOR PAN: So moved. 13 ASSEMBLYMEMBER NAZARIAN: Second. 14 CHAIRPERSON WONG-HERNANDEZ: Motion and a second. 15 Great. 16 THE REPORTER: Who seconded? I'm sorry? 17 CHAIRPERSON WONG-HERNANDEZ: I'm sorry. Second by 18 Mr. Nazarian. 19 MS. JONES: Senator Pan. 20 SENATOR PAN: Aye. 21 MS. JONES: Assemblymember Nazarian. 22 ASSEMBLYMEMBER NAZARIAN: Aye. 23 MS. JONES: Assemblymember Chavez. 24 Assemblymember O'Donnell. 25 ASSEMBLYMEMBER O'DONNELL: Aye.

6 1 MS. JONES: Juan Mireles. 2 MR. MIRELES: Aye. 3 MS. JONES: Cesar Diaz. 4 MR. DIAZ: Aye. 5 MS. JONES: Jeffrey McGuire. 6 MR. McGUIRE: Aye. 7 MS. JONES: Jacqueline Wong-Hernandez? 8 CHAIRPERSON WONG-HERNANDEZ: Aye. MS. JONES: That motion carries. 9 10 CHAIRPERSON WONG-HERNANDEZ: Thank you. Next is 11 the Executive Officer's Statement. 12 MS. SILVERMAN: Yes. Hi. So we wanted to share 13 with the Board tonight that we actually have a bond sale 14 coming up, so we've been sharing that news since last month, 15 but it will actually execute on October 17th, and with that, 16 we are planning to bring apportionments back to this Board. 17 So it would be upward in the area of \$400 million. 18 So we're going to be excited about that. 19 We also notified, at the last meeting, that we are 20 really close to that threshold of having enough --21 sufficient applications to have covered the remaining bond 22 authority. 23 So the applications received beyond authority list 24 has been started and that was effective September 12th, in 25 which we notified the stakeholders that any applications

1 that come in the door subsequent to that date that need -2 they also need to have an additional requirement added to
3 their application when they submit it, is have that Board
4 resolution that actually outlines that there's no guarantee
5 to future funding. So that is in effect.

6 We also wanted to share that the Career Tech 7 Education filing round is still open and the deadline to 8 submit your grant application request for Department of 9 Education review, which is the first step, is October 19th, 10 and we did have some communication with the Department of 11 Education. Probably have a handful of applications, but we 12 understand there will probably be definitely a rush come through October 19th. 13

So we'll have some more updates to share with theBoard about how many applications that came through the doorand are seeking funding.

Full-Day Kindergarten Facility Grant Program, we
actually had two stakeholder meetings and our last
stakeholder meeting was in Van Nuys. So we're actually
having a stakeholder meeting here in Sacramento on
October 4th and it will be in the building.

So we're looking forward to more input. We will
have a draft regulation package and again seeking input from
our stakeholders and we plan to have -- at least our
guideline is to bring that to the October Board for

1 approval.

2 We also wanted to share announcement of the 3 Education Agency Audit Workshops. There's new instructions 4 for the K-12 Audit Program. And so we are partnering up 5 with the Education Audit Appeals Panel and so our first 6 meeting or our first workshop will be October 17th and 7 outlined several workshops, one also in Fresno at the end of 8 October and three in January, one starting in Los Angeles County Office of Education, Sacramento in the middle of 9 10 January and that will also be webcast, and the end of 11 January, we'll have it in San Diego. 12 Space is limited, so please sign up and there will 13 be valuable information for those folks that are going to go 14 out and provide those services, which is your local audit 15 firms and also will be a very good education forum for 16 districts as well. 17 The last point, we have our Board meeting 18 October 24th. We also wanted to share with the Board that 19 the Office of Administrative Law has approved the regulatory 20 amendments for the multipurpose room gym hybrid facilities. 21 That goes into effect January 1st. That's it. 22 CHAIRPERSON WONG-HERNANDEZ: Thank you. Any Board 23 member comments on this or questions? No? Any public 24 comment on this item? Okay. Informational items -- seeing 25 none, we'll move onto the Consent Agenda.

1 MS. SILVERMAN: Consent is ready for your 2 approval. 3 SENATOR PAN: So move. 4 MR. MIRELES: Second. 5 CHAIRPERSON WONG-HERNANDEZ: Motion and a second. 6 And so can we do without objection or do we need to take a vote --7 8 MS. JONES: We need the roll. 9 CHAIRPERSON WONG-HERNANDEZ: Go for it. 10 MS. JONES: Senator Pan. 11 SENATOR PAN: Aye. 12 MS. JONES: Assemblymember Nazarian. 13 ASSEMBLYMEMBER NAZARIAN: Aye. 14 MS. JONES: Assemblymember O'Donnell. 15 ASSEMBLYMEMBER O'DONNELL: Aye. 16 MS. JONES: Juan Mireles. 17 MR. MIRELES: Aye. 18 MS. JONES: Cesar Diaz. 19 MR. DIAZ: Aye. 20 MS. JONES: Jeffrey McGuire. 21 MR. McGUIRE: Aye. 22 MS. JONES: Jacqueline Wong-Hernandez. 23 CHAIRPERSON WONG-HERNANDEZ: Aye. 24 MS. JONES: And that motion carries. 25 CHAIRPERSON WONG-HERNANDEZ: Thank you. Okay.

1 Moving onto the next item. I know these are information 2 items, but it's really just if Board members have questions 3 on either the status of fund releases or --4 MS. SILVERMAN: Yeah. The financial reports. 5 CHAIRPERSON WONG-HERNANDEZ: Right. Yeah. 6 Please. 7 MS. SILVERMAN: The Board just approved 16 8 projects for nearly \$47 million. So that's the highlight of 9 the Consent Agenda and we also did have some funds that came 10 back to the program that was close to \$900,000. So that was 11 pretty much the status of funds. 12 CHAIRPERSON WONG-HERNANDEZ: Great. Any public 13 comment? Seeing none --14 MS. SILVERMAN: The appeal? 15 CHAIRPERSON WONG-HERNANDEZ: Yeah. The last item 16 we really have is the appeal. 17 MS. KAMPMEINERT: So the appeal is for Lake 18 Elementary School District in Glenn County. Staff does 19 recommend approval of this appeal. It is a change of scope 20 request due to financial constraints. The district is 21 asking to reduce from six classrooms to two classrooms and 22 go from a permanent to a modular multipurpose room. 23 Staff believes the project still maintains its 24 core purpose and it's not in violation of any of our 25 procedures for change of scope. So we recommend approval.

1 SENATOR PAN: Move approval. 2 ASSEMBLYMEMBER NAZARIAN: Second. 3 CHAIRPERSON WONG-HERNANDEZ: Motion and a second. 4 Any public comment on this before we vote? Seeing none --5 MS. JONES: Okay. Senator Pan. 6 SENATOR PAN: Aye. 7 MS. JONES: Assemblymember Nazarian. 8 Assemblymember O'Donnell. 9 ASSEMBLYMEMBER O'DONNELL: Aye. 10 MS. JONES: Juan Mireles. 11 MR. MIRELES: Aye. 12 MS. JONES: Cesar Diaz. 13 MR. DIAZ: Aye. 14 MS. JONES: Jeffrey McGuire. 15 MR. McGUIRE: Aye. 16 MS. JONES: Jacqueline Wong-Hernandez. 17 CHAIRPERSON WONG-HERNANDEZ: Ave. 18 MS. JONES: And that motion carries. 19 CHAIRPERSON WONG-HERNANDEZ: Thank you. All 20 right. And then the last is just projected workload and 21 dates, more information. Does anybody have any questions on that? This is all your stuff in the last tab. 22 23 MS. SILVERMAN: And we also wanted to share 24 there's a Board meeting that has been set for December 11th 25 at 2:00 o'clock.
